



SAFETY RECALL NOTICE STOP SALE COMMUNICATION

Date: March 15, 2018

To: All U.S. Maserati Dealers
Subject: Safety Recall 365 – MY 2017 Maserati Quattroporte vehicles, equipped with the V6 gasoline engine, as well as MY 2017 Maserati Ghibli vehicles.

Effective immediately, the vehicles listed in the attachment must not be delivered to customers. The subject vehicles are included in a safety recall related to an engine software defect. If the vehicle is being operated at speeds of approximately 2 miles per hour (low engine RPM), which can be encountered during heavy stop-and-go (bumper-to-bumper) traffic conditions, the transmission may shift into neutral or park or the engine may shut down. If the engine software defect causes the transmission to shift into neutral or park or the engine shuts down unexpectedly, there could be an increased risk of a vehicle crash without prior warning.

Vehicles in the recall will require a “re-flash” or upload of a new software version into the engine control module. Maserati intends to notify owners on or before 05/03/2018 to schedule appointments to have their vehicles fixed.

The remedy for this condition is not currently available. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in April 2018.

Please be reminded that it is a violation of Federal law for you to deliver a new motor vehicle covered by this notification under a sale or lease until the defect is remedied. Violation of this requirement by could result in a civil penalty of up to \$21,000 per vehicle. You must correct all vehicles in your new vehicle inventory before delivery.
