Subject: Upcoming Safety Recall 18156  
Seat Belt Lap Anchor Tensioner Cable

Models: 2015-2016 Chevrolet Silverado and Tahoe  
Police Pursuit and Special Service Vehicles

To: All General Motors Dealers

General Motors has notified the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) about an upcoming safety recall that involves 2015-2016 model year Chevrolet Silverado and Tahoe police and special-service vehicles. The GM recall number is 18156.

It is a violation of federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire) covered by this notification until the defect is remedied.

General Motors has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain 2015 – 2016 Chevrolet Silverado and Tahoe police and special-service vehicles. In rare circumstances based on usage, the flexible steel cable that connects the driver's seat belt to the outboard side of the seat (the "pretensioner cable") can fatigue and may separate over time as a result of occupant movement into the driver's seat. If a pretensioner cable were to break, it would reduce the effectiveness of the vehicle's seat belts and increase the risk of injury to the driver in a crash.

Parts are not currently available, but when parts are available, dealers are to replace the pretensioner cable and seat side-shield.

Until further instructions are received, involved vehicles that are in dealers' possession (new or used vehicle inventory, GM Certified Used, courtesy transportation vehicles, dealer shuttle vehicles, etc.) must be held and not delivered to customers, dealer-traded, released to auction, used for demonstration purposes or any other dealer use. All GM Certified Used vehicles currently in the dealers' inventory within the Certified Pre-Owned Inventory System (CPOIS) will be de-certified.

The Investigate Vehicle History (IVH) screen in the Global Warranty Management (GWM) system has been updated for this upcoming recall on May 03, 2018. This action has been taken to assist dealers with determining which vehicles are involved so they can properly respond to customer inquiries. Also, attached to this message is a list of anticipated questions and answers regarding this upcoming safety recall. Dealers should refer to this information as they respond to customer concerns.

Dealers will be advised when the recall bulletin is released. Until the recall bulletin is released, the IVH screen in GWM will display "N/A" under Release Date and

"Incomplete – Remedy not yet available" under Status. This means the required repair is not yet available and dealers should not attempt to perform any repairs.
