Stop-Drive Information

Date:

- Volkswagen has issued an urgent stop-drive notice for vehicles affected by Safety Recall 40N4. Affected vehicles should NOT be driven until the recall repair has been completed.
- Owners are advised: DO NOT DRIVE THE VEHICLE: contact VW Roadside Assistance a 1-800-411-6688 to make arrangements for the vehicle to be towed to an authorized Volkswagen dealer for repair.
- Provide a **FREE** loaner vehicle for affected owners if necessary.
- Quarantine all affected vehicles in dealer inventory (including those being used by dealership personnel or as demonstrator vehicles) until they are repaired.

Issue:

The nut holding the lower ball joint of the front wheel in each side may be loose or improperly torqued. A loose or improperly torqued ball joint nut can result in dislocation of the lower ball joint. This may cause steering, traction or other stability issues relating to the front wheels and potentially result in a crash.

Repair:

- REPAIR AVAILABLE on May 25, 2018
- Replace the nut of the lower ball joint (ball joint to wheel bearing housing) on both sides of each affected vehicle.

Additional Information:

- Affected vehicles: certain 2018 MY Volkswagen Tiguan (360 USA / 81 Canada)
- Check daily campaign open inventory report or OMD for affected vehicles in inventory
- Repair every affected inventory vehicle before delivery to consumers.
- Owner notification will take place in May 2018

IMPORTANT REMINDER: VEHICLES AFFECTED BY SAFETY & COMPLIANCE RECALLS

New Vehicles in Dealer Inventory: It is a violation of Federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire) covered by this notification under a sale or lease until the defect or noncompliance is remedied. By law, dealers must correct, prior to delivery for sale or lease, any vehicle that fails to comply with an applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard or that contains a defect relating to motor vehicle safety.

Pre-Owned Vehicles in Dealer Inventory: Dealers should not deliver any pre-owned vehicles in their inventory which are involved in a safety or compliance recall until the defect has been remedied.
