Issue: The seat-mounted head/thorax airbag installed in the front passenger seat may not have been folded according to Audi manufacturing specifications. Because of this, the Out of Position test requirements of the voluntary "Recommended Procedures for Evaluating Occupant Injury Risk from Deploying Side Airbags" may not be met.

Affected vehicles still comply with all FMVSS and U.S. NCAP requirements, and all other parts of the "Recommended Procedures for Evaluating Occupant Injury Risk from Deploying Side Airbags" are fulfilled.

Repair:

- REPAIR NOT YET AVAILABLE
- When parts are available, dealers will replace the front passenger seat-mounted side airbag in affected vehicles.
- Check daily campaign open inventory report or OMD for affected vehicles in inventory

IMPORTANT REMINDER: VEHICLES AFFECTED BY SAFETY & COMPLIANCE RECALLS

New Vehicles in Dealer Inventory: It is a violation of Federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire) covered by this notification under a sale or lease until the defect or noncompliance is remedied. By law, dealers must correct, prior to delivery for sale or lease, any vehicle that fails to comply with an applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard or that contains a defect relating to motor vehicle safety.

Pre-Owned Vehicles in Dealer Inventory: Dealers should not deliver any pre-owned vehicles in their inventory which are involved in a safety or compliance recall until the defect has been remedied.
