Background				
Issue What We're Doing	Daimler AG ("DAG"), the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has determined that on certain MY 2018 S-Class and S-Class Coupe/Cabriolet (222, 217 platform) AMG vehicles, certain parameters of the Active Lane Keeping Assist within the software of the multipurpose camera might not meet production specification. Incorrect software calibration could prevent the Active Lane Keeping Assist from initiating braking intervention in cases of unintended lane changes at speeds exceeding 65 miles per hour. Although the driver will still be alerted of unintended lane changes, the crash prevention functionality of the assistant system might be reduced, increasing the risk of a crash. MBUSA will conduct a voluntary recall. As a precautionary measure an authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer will update the multipurpose camera SCN Coding.

Incorrect software calibration could prevent the Active Lane Keeping Assist from initiating braking intervention in cases of unintended lane changes at speeds exceeding 65 miles per hour. Although the driver will still be alerted of unintended lane changes, the crash prevention functionality of the assistant system might be reduced, increasing the risk of a crash. An authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer will update the multipurpose camera SCN Coding.

Prior to performing this Recall Campaign:

- Please check VMI to determine if the vehicle is involved in the Campaign and if it has been previously repaired.
- Please review the entire Recall Campaign bulletin and follow the repair procedure exactly as described.
