Advance Notice – Compliance Recall 94L1 / Passenger Side LED Headlamp

Date: October 15, 2018

Issue: The right (passenger side) headlamp in affected vehicles may not be positioned correctly. This makes the headlamp noncompliant with FMVSS 108 *Lamps, Reflective Devices, and Associated Equipment* and CMVSS 108 - *Lighting System and Retroreflective Devices*. If this condition is present in the vehicle, it may reduce nighttime visibility for the driver.

Repair:

- REPAIR NOT YET AVAILABLE
- When parts become available, dealers will replace the right (passenger) side headlamp in affected vehicles.
- Check daily campaign open inventory report or OMD for affected vehicles in inventory

IMPORTANT REMINDER: VEHICLES AFFECTED BY SAFETY & COMPLIANCE RECALLS

New Vehicles in Dealer Inventory: It is a violation of Federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire) covered by this notification under a sale or lease until the defect or noncompliance is remedied. By law, dealers must correct, prior to delivery for sale or lease, any vehicle that fails to comply with an applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard or that contains a defect relating to motor vehicle safety.

Pre-Owned Vehicles in Dealer Inventory: Dealers should not deliver any pre-owned vehicles in their inventory which are involved in a safety or compliance recall until the defect has been remedied.
