



## **New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – UB2**

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2017 and 2018 model year (BU) Jeep® Renegade vehicles equipped with a 2.4L engine and Flex Fuel option.

VINs identified as being involved in this campaign are currently live and searchable.  
**Stop sale is in effect for the above-identified vehicles.**

Vehicles impacted by a stop sale are eligible for reimbursement allowance through the Recall Floorplan Reimbursement Policy (RFPRP), which can be requested upon recall claim submission.

**IMPORTANT:** Some of the involved vehicles may be in dealer new vehicle inventory. Federal law requires you to complete this recall service on these vehicles before retail delivery. Violation of this requirement by a dealer could result in a civil penalty of up to \$21,000 per vehicle. Involved vehicles can be determined by using the VIP inquiry process.

### **REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL**

Some of the above vehicles may have been built with a fuel pump module which may experience cavitation, this condition will cause loss of fuel pressure under certain environmental conditions while using standard 10% Ethanol (E10) fuel. In some cases, an engine Malfunction Indicator Lamp (MIL) may illuminate, and the engine may operate roughly, hesitate and/or experience reduced engine power. **A loss of fuel pressure may lead to an engine stall resulting in a sudden loss of motive power, which may cause a vehicle crash without prior warning.**

### **SERVICE ACTION**

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall to replace the fuel pump module. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. **This recall is estimated to launch in 4th Quarter of 2018.**
