SAFETY RECALL NOTICE: 18V746

TO: Affected KME Dealers

KME has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain model year 2015-2017 KME vehicles manufactured from July 2015 through October 2017 equipped with certain Hale portable pumps using Kubota Diesel Engines. Accordingly, a recall to address this issue is expected to start on or before December 14, 2018.

KME was informed by Hale that the LED warning lamps for temperature and oil pressure may not be wired correctly and therefore may not activate at the appropriate time. If the LED warning lamps do not activate as intended, in the case of a problem with the engine, they may not provide adequate warning before the engine stops operating. If the engine and pump stops operating, this may potentially increase the risk of injury during firefighting operations.

Owners will be notified by mail about the recall and will be instructed to contact Hale Customer Service to implement this recall remedy. They will also be instructed to contact their KME Dealer or KME if they need any further assistance. There is no cost to owners for this recall.

Please be reminded that it is a violation of Federal law for you deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment covered by this notification until this defect has been remedied. Substantial civil penalties apply to violations of this law.
