



New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – UB7

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2019 model year (DT) RAM 1500 Pickup Trucks.

VINs identified as being involved in this campaign are currently live and searchable.
Stop sale is in effect for the above-identified vehicles.

Vehicles impacted by a stop sale are eligible for reimbursement allowance through the Recall Floorplan Reimbursement Policy (RFPRP), which can be requested upon recall claim submission.

IMPORTANT: Some of the involved vehicles may be in dealer new vehicle inventory. Federal law requires you to complete this recall service on these vehicles before retail delivery. Violation of this requirement by a dealer could result in a civil penalty of up to \$21,000 per vehicle. Involved vehicles can be determined by using the VIP inquiry process.

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

Some of the above vehicles may have been built with a seat track position sensor, located on the manual passenger seat, that may become loose and out of position. An out of position seat track position sensor may be unable to detect the full forward seat position preventing the Occupant Restraint Controller from choosing the desired passenger airbag deployment parameters. A passenger airbag deploying with other than the desired parameters in a crash may result in an increased risk of injury to the passenger, if the seat is in the full forward position.

SERVICE ACTION

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall to inspect for a loose manual passenger seat track position sensor bracket and replace if necessary. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 4th Quarter of 2018.
