Issue:	The underhood fuel supply hose quick connector may not be securely attached to the fuel supply line. There is a risk that the fuel line may open at the quick connector, which may cause fuel to leak into the engine compartment. Leaking fuel, in the presence of an ignition source may result in a fire.	
Precautions	If a fuel smell is detected in the vehicle, customers are advised to contact an authorized Volkswagen dealer without delay to have the vehicle inspected.

Notes:	 Schedule repairs immediately At no cost to customers, dealers will remove the guide sleeve from the fuel line. 	<u>New Vehicles in Dealer Inventory:</u> It is a violation of federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire) covered by this notification under a sale or lease until the defect or noncompliance is remedied. By law, dealers must correct, prior to delivery for sale or lease, any vehicle that fails to comply with an applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard or that contains a defect relating to motor vehicle safety. <u>Pre-Owned Vehicles in Dealer Inventory:</u> Dealers should not deliver any pre-owned vehicles in their inventory which are involved in a safety or compliance recall until the defect has been remedied.
