TO: U.S. and Canadian Distributors
Dealer Principals, Service Managers, Warranty Managers, Parts Managers.

This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act and Canadian Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Autocar, LLC, has determined that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2019 model year Xpeditor chassis. These chassis were manufactured between May 1 2018 and December 1, 2018, with non-sequential serial numbers in the range 227100 through 229567. Accordingly, a recall to address this issue is being initiated effective January 29, 2019.

MODELS Autocar Xpeditor MY 2019.
AFFECTED:

COMPONENTS Universal Joint Strap Bolt Torque.
AFFECTED:

SAFETY DEFECTS If the universal joint strap bolts are loose and become disconnected, the drive shaft
AND POTENTIAL could detach from the vehicle increasing the risk of personal injury or property damage.
RISKS:

REPAIR The pinch bolt torque will be inspected and adjusted as needed.
REQUIRED:

REPAIR VIN profiles in the Autocar Warranty System will be updated to show the open recall on
AVAILABLE: January 29, 2019 and a spreadsheet of the affected VINs will be available in the
Warranty system.

REMINDER: It is a violation of Federal law to sell or lease a vehicle covered by this recall notice
unless the recall remedy has been completed. Substantial civil penalties apply to
violations of this law.
