SAFETY RECALL NOTICE – NHTSA CAMPAIGN NUMBER 18V-189

This notice applies to your vehicle 1C9SS2115FAXXXXXX

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

REASON FOR THIS RECALL

Columbia Northwest, Inc., has decided that a non-compliance regarding the Part 567 Certification Label and FMVSS 110 Tire Placard exists on certain 2010-2017 Somerset E3 camping trailers. These trailers do not accurately indicate the Gross Axle Weight Rate (GAWR). There is a potential for the owners to overload a trailer based on the inaccurate GAWR information currently on the labels which could increase the risk of a crash. The proper weight and loading information is provided below and on the enclosed labels.

Gross Vehicle Weight Rating	4118 lbs
Gross Axle Weight Rating	3500 lbs
Cargo Carrying Capacity	1210 lbs

WHAT WE ARE DOING

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO

Please verify the 17-digit Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) matches the VIN on your trailer and cover your current labels with the attached labels. If you have any questions or concerns, we recommend you contact the Somerset customer service department at 724-237-5227.
