Dear General Motors Customer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

General Motors has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2018 model year Buick Regal vehicles. As a result, GM is conducting a safety recall. We apologize for this inconvenience. However, we are concerned about your safety and continued satisfaction with our products.

#### IMPORTANT

- Your vehicle is involved in GM recall 18117.
- Schedule an appointment with your GM dealer.
- This service will be performed for you at **no charge**.

# Why is your vehicle being recalled?

The rear outboard seats may have seat belts improperly routed around the rear seat bolster bracket during the manufacturing process. Improperly routed seat belts may not provide adequate restraint to passengers in those seats in a crash. If a rear outboard seat belt fails to provide adequate restraint, a passenger in that seat could face an increased risk of injury.

### What will we do?

Your GM dealer will inspect the rear outboard seat belts to verify proper routing around the side bolster bracket. If necessary, the dealer will correctly reroute the seat belts. This service will be performed for you at **no charge**. Because of service scheduling requirements, it is likely that your dealer will need your vehicle longer than the actual inspection and service correction time of approximately 30 minutes.

# What should you do?

You should contact your GM dealer to arrange a service appointment as soon as possible.
