This notice applies to your vehicle identified on the enclosed card.

Dear IC Bus Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

IC Bus has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2019 CE school bus models built 01/25/2018 thru 02/01/2018 with feature code 04091 (dual air brake system) and 04AZS (Antilock Brake System [ABS] with 4 channel Electronic Stability Protection [ESP]).

REASON FOR THIS RECALL

The roll stability valve air supply line may be incorrectly routed. This condition does not affect normal brake operation. However, during a stability control oversteer event and with slippery road conditions, the parking brakes may be modulated unintentionally.

RISK TO MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY

Modulation of the parking brake during a stability control oversteer event could lead to loss of control or a vehicle crash.

DEFECT REMEDY

The remedy will involve correctly routing the roll stability valve supply line. Dealers have parts and instructions to repair your vehicle. The repair will be performed free of charge and take approximately 1 hour to complete.

ACTIONS YOU SHOULD TAKE

If you own this vehicle, please schedule an appointment with any IC Bus dealer to have your vehicle repaired. You

can find your nearest dealer by calling 1-800-448-7825 or by using the dealer locator at <http://www.icbus.com>.

If you have already paid for repairs that corrected the defect, you may be eligible for reimbursement of certain repair expenses. Present your original repair paperwork and proof of payment to any IC Bus dealer and your eligibility will be reviewed. You may also submit a claim using the enclosed Request for Reimbursement card.

If you are the lessor of this vehicle, please forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days to comply with federal regulations.

If you do not own this vehicle, please fill out and return mail the enclosed card so that you will not be contacted again about this recall.

IF YOU NEED ASSISTANCE

If you believe that IC Bus has failed to remedy the defect without charge or within a reasonable time, please follow the procedure described in the Owner Assistance Guide section in your Owner's Manual or call toll free 1-800-448-7825.
