Dear Kenworth Customer,

Kenworth previously notified you that one or more of your vehicles was being recalled for a noncompliance with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard 121 because the dash warning lamp for the antilock brake system (ABS) may not illuminate when the ABS is offline due to loss of battery or ignition power. Further investigation showed that the software installed in your vehicle(s) functions properly and our initial determination of noncompliance with respect to your vehicle(s) was incorrect. Your ABS lamp will illuminate if the ABS module loses power, thus alerting the driver to the existence of a problem so that corrective action can be sought.
