Dear Valued Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Spartan Motors USA, Inc. has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain model year 2009-2018 Gladiator and MetroStar model emergency vehicles manufactured between June 4, 2009 and May 17, 2018.

Please note: The Vehicle Identification Number that may be affected by this recall is located at the top of this letter.

What is the defect?

The interior parts of the solenoid, used in the control circuit for the fire pump, may become corroded and subsequently fail without warning. When the solenoid fails, power to the pump control module (pressure governor) may be lost.

A loss of power to the pressure governor could cause loss of pressure and flow during pumping operations. This increases the risk of personal injury and equipment damage.

Corrective Action:

Repair kits that include a new solenoid will be supplied at no charge.

Labor Time:

Removal and reinstallation of the solenoids may take up to 2 hours. However, due to some service scheduling times, your service center may need your vehicle for a longer period.

What You Should Do:

Call Spartan at 1-800-543-5008 to locate a qualified service center near you. Steps will be taken to ensure the recall is performed at the nearest service center.

Leased Vehicles:

The lessor must notify the lessee by first class mail within ten (10) days from receipt of their owner notification letter from the manufacturer; both for the initial notification and all subsequent notifications.

Reimbursement:

If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall. For more information contact Spartan at 1-800-543-5008.

Reply Card:

Please fill out the enclosed prepaid postcard and mail it to us if you have changed your address, sold, or traded the vehicle.

If the authorized service center has failed or is unable to remedy the defect without charge and within a reasonable time, contact Spartan at 1-800-543-5008.
