This notice applies to Your Lamborghini Aventador with the VIN XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX

Dear Lamborghini Owner, Lessee,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Automobili Lamborghini S.p.A. has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain Model Year 2015 and 2016 Aventador SV Coupè and Aventador SV Roadster vehicles. Our records indicate that you are the owner of a vehicle in this recall.

Why are we contacting You?

Please contact your authorized Lamborghini dealer immediately to schedule an appointment to have this important free update performed as soon as possible. You can locate your nearest authorized Lamborghini Dealer at <https://www.lamborghini.com/en-en/ownership/dealer-locator>

What is the issue?

The affected vehicles might, under certain conditions of usage of the vehicle the wheel centering bushes drive pegs (bolts centering and supporting the brake discs to the wheel's hub) may become loose increasing the risk of a crash.

Vibrations and stress factors over time may cause the drive pegs to come loose in the VIN range affected.

With loose drive pegs and continued use for a long time, this may lead to an overstress of the wheel locking system with risk of its fracture, increasing the risk of a crash.

What will Lamborghini do?

Dealers will replace center locks and the drive pegs with ones with loctite capsules "Free of Charge". The repair could take up to one hour. We apologize for any inconvenience this recall may cause.

Please bring this letter and your Service Booklet with you when you visit the dealer, so that we can make all necessary entries.

What if you are not the current owner of this vehicle?

You can update your vehicle ownership or contact information by filling out the enclosed document (Appendix A) and sending it to Lamborghini by following the detailed instructions present on it.

If you are a vehicle lessor, Federal Regulations require you to forward this notice to your lessee within ten days.


