IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

This notice applies to your vehicle (s)

Subject: Brake Mounting Caliper Bolts

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Daimler Trucks North America LLC (DTNA), on behalf of its Freightliner Trucks Division, has decided that a defect that relates to motor vehicle safety exists on specific Freightliner 108SD, 114SD, 122SD, Business Class M2, Cascadia, Columbia and Coronado, vehicles manufactured January 2, 2017, through July 9, 2018, and equipped with air disc brakes.

On certain vehicles, insufficiently torqued caliper mounting bolts may not provide adequate clamping force between the brake caliper and the brake anchor plate, potentially resulting in reduced brake effectiveness, which could increase the risk of a crash.

Caliper mounting bolts will be inspected and torqued or replaced as needed.

The recall repair will begin October 12, 2018. Please contact an authorized Daimler Trucks North America dealer to arrange to have the Recall performed and to ensure that parts are available at the dealership. To locate an authorized dealer, search online at www.Daimler-TrucksNorthAmerica.com. On the menu tab, select "Contact," scroll down to "Find a Dealer," and select the appropriate brand. The Recall will take up to four hours, depending on the work needed, and will be performed at no charge to you.

You may be liable for any progressive damage that results from your failure to complete the Recall within a reasonable time after receiving notification.

If you do not own the vehicle that corresponds to the identification number(s) which appears on the Recall Notification, please return the notification to the Warranty Campaigns Department with any information you can furnish that will assist us in locating the present owner. If you have leased this vehicle, Federal law requires that you forward this notice to the lessee within 10 days. If you are a subsequent stage manufacturer, Federal law requires that you forward this notice to your distributors and retail outlets within five working days. If you have paid to have this recall condition corrected prior to this notice, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement. Please see the reverse side of this notice for details.
