Dear Volkswagen Owner,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Volkswagen has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain 2018 model year Volkswagen e-Golf and Golf R vehicles. Our records show that you are the owner of a vehicle affected by this action.

What is the issue? The rear seat head restraint guide sleeves may have been improperly

welded to the seat frame structure. In a crash, there may be an increased risk of injury to vehicle occupants due to the reduced stability of the rear

seat head restraints.

What will we do? To correct this defect, your authorized Volkswagen dealer will inspect the

welding connection between the rear seat frame and the head restraint guide sleeve and, if insufficient welding is found, the rear seat frame will be replaced. This work will take up to two hours to complete and will be

performed for you free of charge.
