This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Porsche has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in all 2017 and 2018 Model Year Porsche Panamera vehicles. Our records show that you are the owner of a vehicle affected by this action.

What is the issue?

Due to a possible software failure, the electronic power steering assist might become intermittently unavailable. If this occurs and the electronic power steering assistance is temporarily disabled, a stronger than normal force could be required in order to turn the steering wheel. In certain traffic situations, this could increase the risk of a crash.

What will we do?

Porsche is conducting a safety recall and re-programming the affected components. Vehicles affected by this action will be recalled to the workshop to have the power steering control unit re-programmed with an optimized software. These repairs will be completed at no charge to you.

What should you do?

Please make contact with your authorized Porsche dealership to schedule a repair appointment, and to arrange in advance for a Porsche loaner vehicle should you require alternate transportation during the repair period. Re-programming the affected components is expected to take approximately one hour to complete.

Lease vehicles and address change

If you are the lessor and registered owner of the vehicle identified in this action, the law requires you to forward this letter immediately via first-class mail to the lessee within ten days of receipt. If you have changed your address or sold the vehicle, please fill out the enclosed prepaid Owner Reply Card and mail it to us so we can update our records.
