Zinger/Longhorn GFCI Ground Wire

Keystone is conducting a voluntary RECALL notification campaign in accordance with the National Highway Transportation and Safety Act. It has been decided that the vehicles in the recall population may have a ground wire at the GFCI receptacle improperly installed. If the ground wire shorts, there is an increased risk of damage or fire to the unit.

Tools Required: - Screw driver - Wire cutters - Crimp tool

<u>Note – Check serial number on Key Express to verify the campaign is open. Some vehicles were repaired before they left Keystone.</u>

When performing warranty or recall service, please make certain that appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is used.

REPAIR INSTRUCTIONS



Step 1

Verify on Key Express that the unit requires repair.

Step 2

Locate the GFCI receptacle in the unit that has the test button on the receptacle. There is only one receptacle like this in the unit, Figure 1.



Step 3

Remove the receptacle and inspect the bare copper ground wires for proper installation, Figure 2. There should be a copper crimp connecter that crimps the ground wires together.

Step 4

If there is a copper crimp connecter, as in Figure 2, attached to the bare copper wires, proceed to Warranty Reimbursement. If not continue to step 5.

Step 5

If there is <u>no</u> copper crimp connector (see Figure 3), remove the wire from the GFCI receptacle and install an approved connecter as listed under the "Parts Required" section above. Reattach the ground wire to the GFCI receptacle and install the GFCI receptacle in receptacle box. Proceed to Warranty Reimbursement.



WARRANTY REIMBURSEMENT

Submit a claim on Key Express using Flat Rate Code # 7131442F.

- In the "Complaint" section note "Safety Advisory # 18-314".
- In the "Cause" section note "Copper crimp connector installed" or "No copper crimp connector installed".
- In the "Correction" section note "No repair needed" or "Installed copper crimp connector".

The amount of time authorized for repair is .5 hour per vehicle to inspect and repair.
