Field Repair Work Instruction

Modify "Hopkins" Electronic Taillight Converter Harness

(1/2 hour labor allowance @ \$68/hr. + \$5 applicable shop supplies)

2.0 STEP 1: Locate the converter module

Part is a small black plastic module with "Hopkins Electronic Taillight Converter" marked on one side. Converter will be hard wired into the taillight harness, and is identifiable with a hiker plug attached at one end. Typical location will be on the Van Body's subframe, aft axle on the driver's side




3.0 STEP 2: Modification

- a. Remove wire tie to allow Converter with Hiker plug to be lowered for access
- Using wire cutters, cut <u>individually</u> all five (5) harness wires approximately 2 inches from end of converter, remove and save converter
- c. Install heat sealable butt connectors (size 14-16 Blue) onto all five (5) cut wires of the harness.
- d. Crimp the connector to the wire using the crimping component of the wire crimping tool (tug on wire to ensure a tight fit).
- e. Using a heat gun, apply heat to the connector until glue secretes from the connector around the wire repeat on all wires
- f. Using a heat gun, apply heat to the end of the connector and crimp end Flat or Closed repeat on all wires
- g. Wrap all wires with electrical tape and re-secure harness with a wire tie to underside of body
- h. Re-secure harness with wire ties to original location
- Confirm that Lights are operational and compliant to FMVSS-108.

4.0 STEP 3: Return Old Harness

In order to be reimbursed for the work, the removed harness must be returned. Ensure that the removed part is identified with the Morgan Van Body Serial #.
