PURPOSE

This campaign bulletin instructs dealers to apply a new overlay label that covers the incorrect rear wheel rim size portion of the original certification label.

BACKGROUND

Due to a production oversight, the incorrect rear wheel rim size was entered into the label printing system. The Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards (FMVSS) certification label on affected vehicles shows a rear wheel rim size of "17X7.03" instead of the correct "18X7.03." If the vehicle's wheels are replaced with those of an incorrect rim size, it can result in an increased risk of a vehicle crash.

AFFECTED VEHICLES

2018 - 2019 Outlander built between August 8, 2017 - July 26, 2018

IMPORTANT

Affected new or used inventory vehicles must be repaired before the vehicle is sold/delivered. Dealers must check their inventory vehicles' VINs on the Warranty Superscreen to verify whether the vehicle is involved in this recall campaign. It is a violation of Federal law for a dealer to sell/deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire) covered by the notification under a sale or lease until the defect or noncompliance is remedied.


REQUIRED OPERATIONS

Before starting this campaign procedure, **CHECK THE WARRANTY SUPERSCREEN** to verify if the vehicle is an affected VIN for this campaign and this campaign procedure has not already been completed.

REQUIRED EQUIPMENT

- Clean cloth
- Isopropyl (rubbing) alcohol
- Painter's tape or equivalent (removable masking tape)

INSPECTION PROCEDURE



. Open the driver's door and locate the certification label.



 Confirm if the part number on the original label is "7430C**541**" and the rear wheel rim size is "17X7.03."

If the label's part number is "7430C**541**" and the rear wheel rim size is "17X7.03," proceed to the "Label Installation Procedure."

If the label's part number is **NOT** "7430C**541**" or the rear wheel rim size is "18X7.03," this is not an affected vehicle. Do **NOT** proceed to the "Label Installation Procedure."


LABEL INSTALLATION PROCEDURE



Do NOT use a denatured alcohol or any other higher solutions of alcohol.



3. Gently clean and dry the surface of the original label with isopropyl alcohol and a clean cloth.




4. Place a piece of painter's tape (or equivalent) over the top of the bar code to use as a horizontal guide for positioning the overlay label.

Note: Another piece of painter's tape may be used along the left edge of the label as a vertical guide, if desired.

A CAUTION

Do NOT apply the painter's tape over any part of the label above the bar code.



5. Carefully remove the backing of the overlay label.

Be careful **NOT** to touch the adhesive side of the label. The adhesive will lose effectiveness if it is touched.



6. Apply the overlay label onto the original label.

IMPORTANT: Ensure the overlay label is properly positioned before allowing contact with the original label.

If the overlay label is not properly positioned or damaged, remove the label and dispose of it, and apply a new label.

a. Carefully align the overlay label with the vertical edge of the original label (or vertical painter's tape guide if used) and the top edge of the horizontal painter's tape guide, as shown.



b. Once the overlay label is properly positioned, use your thumb to work out any air-bubbles or creases, starting from the bottom edge to the top edge.



- 7. Remove the painter's tape carefully.
- 8. Close the driver's door to complete the procedure.



LABOR AND PARTS:

There are 2 possible repair scenarios for this campaign. #1 is for all dealers except AVIS, #2 is for AVIS only.

Replace with 1 label from this part number: 7430C786

Although there 2 labels per part number, if claimed, you will be reimbursed ½ the dealer net price + markup. Use applicable campaign labor operation below.
