Instructions:

NOTE: TAKE CARE WHEN COMPLETING RECALL AND ENSURE LP IS SHUT OFF BEFORE STARTING ANY REPAIRS. PLEASE WEAR APPROPRIATE SAFETY GEAR

TMC WILL NOT COVER ANY DAMAGES INCURRED DURING THE COMPLETION OF THE PROCESS

1. **IMPORTANT-** Only perform the LP Hose replacement once the notch in the bottom metal plate has been made (See pdf named “RC000162 Recall Instructions” for this information).
2. Unhook LP hose from valve in thru access door.



3. Find routing of LP hose under motorhome and unhook other end from propane manifold. P-clamps may need to be removed during process for easier replacement of hose. (NOTE- routing of LP hose will vary based on floor plan on motorhome)

3. Once original LP hose is removed, replace with new one according to list on page 1.
4. Use a thread sealant when connecting LP hose to manifold.



5. While routing the new LP hose, be sure to re-attach p-clamps to secure hose.

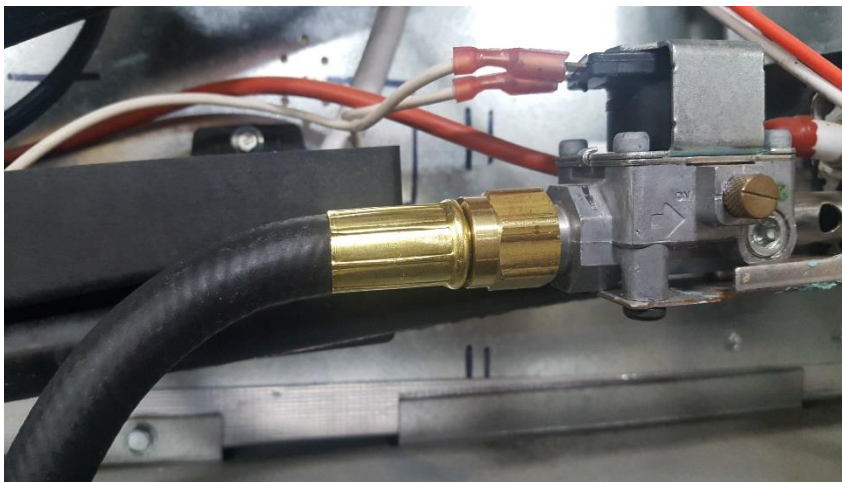

6. Re-route LP hose up through grommet on refer cabinet floor.



7. Attach hose and tighten onto valve. A second wrench will be needed to hold valve in place as to not turn or kink the replacement LP hose.



8. Perform an LP pressure test.
