What's New Abstract	Safety Recall – Parts are available - The webbing of certain IMMI seat belt buckle assemblies, provided for GraMag seats, may have been glued, but not sewn, allowing the seat belt to come apart. Failure to adequately restrain a vehicle occupant during a crash may increase the risk of injury.

Introduction	Kenworth Truck Company has determined that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain T680 and T880 chassis manufactured between 08/18/2017 and 11/27/2017.
Situation	4501 chassis (4044 U.S. and 457 Canada), T680 and T880 vehicles built from 08/18/2017 through 11/27/2017 equipped with GraMag seats equipped with IMMI seat belt buckle assemblies. See the attached chassis list for specific chassis.
Resolution	Remove, inspect, and/or replace the buckle assembly as instructed in the attached Buckle Inspection/Replacement procedure.
It is a violation of Federal law for a dealer to sell or lease new vehicles covered by this recall until the defect or noncompliance has been corrected.
