Situation	2,567 chassis (2,359 U.S. and 208 Canada), T680 and T880 vehicles built from 08/16/2017 through 09/01/2017 equipped with GraMag seats equipped with IMMI seat belt buckle assemblies. See the attached chassis list for specific chassis.
Resolution	This bulletin is for interim notification only. Customer letters will be sent in February, regardless of parts availability, as required by NHTSA. Parts are not currently available and this bulletin will be updated when repair parts are available.
