Dear Valued Customer:

Our records show that Recall 18V-618 remains open on this recreational vehicle. Please contact an authorized Dealer as soon as possible to set an appointment. If the Remedy was performed, please complete and return the Reply Form on the back of this letter to update our records.

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Jayco has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety exits in certain 2019 White Hawk, Jay Flight and Jay Flight SLX travel trailers.

Reason for this recall The Dexter axle may be missing the inner bearing race on the hubs. A missing race could cause increased friction allowing the hub to overheat, which could lead to premature failure, possibly resulting in a separation of the hub from the axle, increasing the risk of a crash..

Recall Remedy Inspection of the axle assembly for the correct specifications of the hub-drum and backing plate. If not to Dexter specifications, the axle will be replaced

What we need you to do Please contact an authorized Dealer as soon as possible to schedule an appointment. The Recall Remedy is free of charge and will take approximately 90 Minutes to complete.

If you had this repair completed prior to receipt of this recall notice, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.

If you take your recreational vehicle to your dealer on the agreed service date and the dealer does not remedy this condition on that date or within three (3) days, please contact our Customer Service Department at 800-283-8267. If you are unable to get this safety defect remedied without charge and/or within a reasonable amount of time after contacting your dealer and Jayco customer service, you may want to contact NHTSA.
