This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Porsche has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain vehicles of the models and model years shown above. A brake line on the front axle may corrode over time. As a result, rust particles could be deposited in the filter elements inside the hydraulic unit and could block it, potentially impairing the performance of the front brakes. Reduced braking ability could increase the risk of a crash. Our records show that you are the owner of a vehicle affected by this action.

Porsche is conducting a safety recall and will replace the affected components at no charge to you. The replacement parts required for remedying your vehicle are currently being manufactured as a matter of high priority. Unfortunately, at this time, parts are not available. Be assured we will keep both you and your authorized Porsche dealer abreast of the necessary parts availability so that repairs may be scheduled as soon as possible.

During this period, your Porsche vehicle remains safe for you to drive. This recall will be carried out at no expense to you. Please be aware that if, after we have notified you that replacement parts for your vehicle are available, you require any assistance in making an appointment to have this recall performed, please call or write:
