Dear Peterbilt Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Peterbilt Motors Company has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain model year 2018 Peterbilt model 567 and 579 vehicles manufactured from 08/23/2017 through 10/18/2017. The webbing on some IMMI seat belt buckle assemblies may not have been sewn during production, and the glue holding the webbing in place may be insufficient to restrain a vehicle occupant during a crash, which may increase the risk of injury or death.

The problem is...

The webbing of certain IMMI seat belt buckle assemblies may have been glued, but not sewn.

What you must do ...

After you receive a follow up letter informing you that parts are available, contact your Peterbilt Dealer to schedule an appointment for repair

Peterbilt has initiated a recall to remedy the defect. **Replacement parts are not yet available from the component supplier.** However, Peterbilt is required to notify customers of the existence of the identified defect. Another letter will be mailed when the repair parts become available.


