In October 2016 DTNA decided to conduct a voluntary safety recall on certain RV chassis with inadequate clearance. In November of 2017 an RV outside of the original population experienced a thermal event. In March of 2018 DTNA decided to expand the population for certain RV Chassis with inadequate clearance.
