



## Chronology of Defect / Noncompliance Determination

*In March 2018 DTNA received information of a potential battery cable rub on certain Saf-T-Liner C2 chassis (when the battery tray is pulled out for service) and began a defect investigation. In April 2018 DTNA decided to conduct a voluntary safety recall on certain Saf-T-Liner C2 buses with potentially inadequate battery cable clearance.*

## Identify the Remedy

*The power cable will be inspected and rerouted for proper clearance when required. Repairs will be performed by Daimler Trucks North America authorized service facilities. Copies of the reimbursement plan will be submitted as a supplemental report when available.*


