

IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL INFORMATION U62 / NHTSA 18V-332

FCA US LLC has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain 2018 model year Jeep® Wrangler vehicles.

You were mailed a safety recall notice in June 2018 asking you to bring your vehicle in to your local dealer so they could inspect the software level of the Powertrain Control Module (PCM) and if necessary, reprogram the PCM. Our records indicate your vehicle was at your dealership and this recall was subsequently closed.

Due to a recall inspection procedure issue, it was determined that your vehicle PCM may not have been properly inspected. We ask that you contact your local dealer to have the inspection of the PCM software level performed again. Your dealer will re-inspect your vehicle and make the necessary repair if required, FREE of charge.
