Since filing the original Defect Information Report on September 27, 2018 Honda has determined that certain 2015 Honda Crosstour vehicles were mistakenly identified as being affected by this recall. The following sections are being amended to reflect this update:

Chronology:

October 8, 2018

Honda determined that 1,905 model year 2015 Honda Crosstour vehicles were mistakenly identified as being affected by this recall. As part of a running change to discontinue using Takata airbag inflators as OEM equipment, these vehicles were built from April 7, 2015 and assembled with passenger frontal airbags containing inflators from an alternate supplier.
