2. Introduction

2.1 Document Purpose

The document outlines the definitions and business rules around identification of Out of Transit VINs for Recall purposes by IHS Markit. The Out of Transit business rules should be agreed upon among **IHS Markit**, **SSA**, **NHTSA** and **OEMs**.

2.2 Summary of Business Objectives

This document defines business rules of the Out of Transit categories that identify candidate records for the SSE process. VINs potentially identified as off the road are based on the recent/latest record of the VIN data received by IHS Markit. All SSE Types that a VIN qualifies for are identified. Out of Transit data shall be re-evaluated monthly.
