## AMENDED INFORMATION REPORT (18V- 883)

This supplements Toyota's Part 573 Report (18V-883) concerning the Takata front passenger inflator issue on certain Toyota, Lexus, and Pontiac Vibe vehicles.

Certain early 2002MY Toyota Sequoia vehicles originally included in this recall were not originally equipped with a Takata front passenger inflator. These vehicles were inspected in the original Takata recall (13V-133). Thus, Toyota is amending its Part 573 Report (18V-883) of December 12, 2018 to remove 488 Sequoia vehicles from the affected population.
