Problem Description:

Chrysler (FCA US LLC) is recalling certain 2019 Jeep Renegade and Fiat 500X vehicles. Incorrect software may cause the occupant restraint controller (ORC) module to disable certain passive safety features.

Consequence:

Deactivated passive safety features can increase the risk of injury in the event of a crash.

Remedy:

Chrysler will notify owners, and dealers will update the ORC module software, free of charge. The recall is expected to begin May 30, 2019. Owners may contact Chrysler's customer service at 1-800-853-1403. Chrysler's number for this recall is V42.

Therefore, the first quarterly report will be due on, or before, 30 days after the close of the calendar quarter.
