Description of the Defect : End of the parking brake cable are too small and could pull out from the retaining clip, causing emergency brake to not engage. Failure is not immediate, park brake could fail after several engagements. Substituted cabel was not inspected nor tested to FMVSS 49CFR571.105 by supplier.

Description of the Safety Risk : If the park brake does not engage, the vehiche may not stay stationary as required on an incline. This could result in personal injury and/or property damage.

Description of the Cause : L & W made a substitution to the brake cable - Jayco was not made aware of the substitution. - The configuration of the ends of the substituted cables are smaller,

Production stopped installing substitution. immediately 2-14-19 Met with L & W to discuss specifics and to address changing a component on a regulatory system without validation. 2-28-19 Safety Committee discuss details of incident and agreed Safety / Non Compliance Recall is required
