5/29/2019 – Report was made through a warranty claim that there was no furnace exhaust vent installed on a Cruiser during PDI at a dealership. Pre-investigation opened. All affected Cruiser Fifth Wheels were put on hold and the furnace exhaust vents were inspected. None were found to be missing.

5/30/2019 – A phone investigation campaign was initiated to investigate if any other units were affected. 6/5/2019 – One more unit was found out of 36 units inspected. Investigation opened for range and scope. Investigation called for to determine affected unit range.

6/6/2019 – Investigation concluded and scope completed. Phone campaign extended for remaining 19 units to alert dealers to inspect for missing furnace vents before retail sale.
