Description of the Defect: The tire tread rubber may partially separate from the tire body on certain

vehicles.

FMVSS 1: NR FMVSS 2: NR

Description of the Safety Risk: If tread rubber partially separates from the tire body, it could lead to vehicle

instability, which may increase the risk of a crash. No accidents, injuries, or

deaths have been reported to date as a result of this defect.

Description of the Cause : In the manufacturing process, rubber compound used for prototype production

was accidentally mixed into rubber compound for standard production which

causes tire tread strength to diminish.

Identification of Any Warning Vibration and/or flapping noise can occur prior to tire tread separation. Partial

that can Occur: rubber separation from the tread or irregular tread wear may also be observed.

Chronology:

September 9, 2019: The tire supplier, Sumitomo Rubber Industries Ltd (SRI), informed Mazda of the following information regarding tire tread rubber separation. SRI received seven reports of warranty information from Saudi Arabia regarding tread rubber separation of an originally equipped tire. The separations occurred in July, 2019. The vehicle owners experienced vehicle vibration or unusual noise and brought their vehicles to tire specialty shops, where tread rubber separations were recognized. SRI collected the concerned tires from Saudi Arabia and had investigated the cause of the failures and found that all of the returned tires were manufactured in the 16th week of 2019 wherein inappropriate materials mixed into the tread rubber in the standard manufacturing process which contributed to the tread rubber separation. They began conducting the evaluation of any safety risk in vehicles.

September 30, 2019: SRI confirmed the shipping and delivery timing of the concerned tires and identified the delivery destinations of the subject tires. As a result of the assessment of safety risk caused by the tread separation, this failure could not lead to the breakage of the base rubber or the belt underneath the tire tread. Therefore, rapid air leakage or tire blowout could not occur, however the tire tread rubber may partially peel off, causing vehicle instability.

October 15, 2019; SRI informed Mazda of tread rubber separation problem on MY2019 CX-9 in the U.S. Three of four tires experienced peeling. A vehicle owner also detected this concern on September 27, 2019. October 21, 2019: SRI submitted the DIR related to this defect to NHTSA, which identified Mazda CX-9 vehicles with affected originally equipped tires.

October 25, 2019; Based on the determination of a field action by SRI, Mazda held a Quality Audit Committee to review all available information to date and determined to conduct a proactive recall action on certain MY2019 CX-9 vehicles in the U.S.

Description of Remedy:

Description of Remedy Program : Owners will be notified by mail and instructed to take their vehicle to a

Mazda dealer.

Dealers will check the serial number on the tire. If applicable, all four (4) tires will be replaced with new tires. There will be no charge for this service to vehicle owners. This defect is applicable to the reimbursement plan Mazda submitted on September 10, 2019. Through this general reimbursement plan, Mazda will reimburse vehicle owners for repair cost incurred due to the subject defect prior to submission of this safety recall.

How Remedy Component Differs The remedy parts were manufactured with proper production rubber

Mazda confirmed no additional tires with irregular rubber compound were delivered to the vehicle assembly plant starting from the 17th week

Since September 9, 2019, the supplier has implemented a process change to prevent prototype rubber compound from being used with standard

production manufacturing equipment.
