10/17/19 Meeting was held with individuals from Production and Engineering to discuss incident. 10/19/19 Conduct field investigations because the prints were spec'd in to use carriage bolts, washers, plates and locking nuts.

10/24/19 Results indicated that we were using self-tapping screws to secure the solar panel to the luggage rack and the screws were either failing or loosening.

10/24/19 TMC Safety Committee met and determined that a recall was needed.

10/30/19 Final scope determined.
