10/4/2019 - Airstream began preliminary discussion regarding a potential OCCC discrepancy, and opened an investigation. 10/22/19 - Airstream Engineering identified a population of motorhomes to investigate further. The process of pulling manual paper unit files to determine weights was started. 11/15/19 - Manual file review was completed. Option weights were reverified along with additional products added to motorhomes based upon option content. 12/5/19 -Investigation was completed by engineering and warranty and the issue was then escalated for review by the Airstream Safety Committee. 12/13/19 - The Airstream Safety committee met and voted to issue a non-compliance recall.
