12/4/19 - Peterbilt Engineering informed Product Safety & Compliance that there were two chassis in the field that had been reported with incorrect front spring brackets. These brackets lacked the correct number of bottom holes to enable complete attachment of the power steering assist bracket.

12/10/19 - The matter was presented to the Peterbilt Safety Committee, which requested more detail on bracket failures in the field. Safety and Compliance contacted Field Service for more information and learned of two trucks on which the power steering assist bracket has broken off due to missing tapped holes to properly mount the bracket.

12/18/19 - The Safety Committee determined that the use of the incorrect front spring bracket was a defect relating to motor vehicle safety.
