



New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – V35

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2019 Model Year (LD) Dodge Charger vehicles.

VINs identified as being involved in this campaign are currently live and searchable.
Stop sale is in effect for the above-identified vehicles.

Vehicles impacted by a stop sale are eligible for reimbursement allowance through the Recall Floorplan Reimbursement Policy (RFPRP), which can be requested upon recall claim submission.

IMPORTANT: Some of the involved vehicles may be in dealer new vehicle inventory. Federal law requires you to complete this recall service on these vehicles before retail delivery. Violation of this requirement by a dealer could result in a civil penalty of up to \$21,000 per vehicle. Involved vehicles can be determined by using the VIP inquiry process.

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

Some of the above vehicles may have been built with the driver's and passenger side sun visor labels that may not have the required airbag deployment warning information. **Failure to provide this required information, could increase the risk of injury in the event of a crash.**

The condition described above does not comply with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 208 S4.5.1(b)(3) requires vehicles to have an air bag deployment warning information label, conforming in content as specified in the standard, permanently affixed to either side of the sun visor at each front outboard seating position that is equipped with an inflatable restraint.

SERVICE ACTION

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall to replace the driver's and passenger side sun visors. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 2nd Quarter of 2019.
