Subject: Recall VIN Load – Launch of Safety Recall 3219D - 2016-2018 Mazda3 Front Windshield Wipers Inoperative Concern Safety Recall

As of today, Tuesday May 7, 2019, owners of affected vehicles in this recall were notified by first class mail. As customary, the Vehicle Identification Numbers were also sent to the MNAO IT Department so they would appear in Open status in eMDCS to coincide with the letter mailing.

However, approximately 145,000 VIN's still show in "Not Launched" status and the remaining 40,000 vehicles do show as Open. The MNAO IT Team is working to resolve the issue as soon as possible and this will be corrected by tomorrow morning, May 8, 2019. The vehicles under Recall 3219D that are in "Not Launched" status should still be repaired as per the Repair Procedure documented on MGSS under the recall as parts are available.
