



New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – V73

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2019 Model Year (BV) Jeep® Renegade vehicles.

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

Vehicles equipped with the Upland trim package and an Occupant Restraint Controller (ORC) calibrated to non-Upland trim package that are involved in a frontal collision with a longitudinal delta-V below 16 MPH sufficient to trigger low-output air bag deployment (stage 1 only) may experience a high-output air bag deployment (stage 1 and stage 2). High-output air bag deployment in low speed vehicle crashes that would otherwise call for low-output air bag deployment in the suspect vehicles may increase the risk of injury to front seat vehicle occupants during a crash.

SERVICE ACTION

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall to reprogram the ORC with updated software. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 2nd Quarter of 2019.
