Keystone RV Company has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain model 2020 Crossroads Cruiser Fifth Wheels. As a result, Keystone RV is conducting a safety recall.

Reason for this recall It has been decided that the vehicles in the recall population may not have the furnace exhaust vent installed on some units. During use of the furnace without an exhaust vent installed, the risk of carbon monoxide poisoning is significantly increased, leading to an increased risk of personal injury. The remedy is to inspect for furnace exhaust vents and install if missing. The vehicles included in the recall are:

2020 Cruiser Fifth Wheels, Models 27MK, 29SI, 28RD, 24RL, 29RK

Serial Number Range: L6320010 - L6320063

Our records indicate unit(s) sold or in your present lot inventory fall within this range, which will require immediate preventative action. **Important:** If some of the units are still in your inventory, Federal Law requires you to complete the recall service on those units before retail delivery.
