

IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

AUTOCAR, LLC SAFETY RECALL ACX-1906 NHTSA RECALL NO. 19V456

This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Autocar, LLC has determined that a defect that relates to motor vehicle safety exists in 275, 2013-2018 model year Xpeditor chassis. These chassis were manufactured between February 6, 2013 and March 23, 2017 with non-sequential serial numbers in the range 215900 through 224163. Accordingly, a recall to address this issue is being initiated effective October 13, 2020.

The drive shaft support cross member may fail

SAFETY DEFECTS AND POTENTIAL

RISKS:

If the cross member is used to support components such as the drive shaft center bearing, in the event of a failure such components may not be supported and may become loose, detached from the vehicle or damage other components during

operation, increasing the risk of a crash, personal injury or property damage.

REPAIR REQUIRED: The drive shaft support cross member will be replaced at no charge to the owner.

REPAIR AVAILABLE: VIN profiles in the Autocar Warranty System will be updated to show the open recall on October 13, 2020 and a spreadsheet of the affected VINs will be available in the

Warranty system.

REMINDER:

It is a violation of Federal law to sell or lease a vehicle covered by this recall notice unless the recall remedy has been completed. Substantial civil penalties apply to violations of this law.
