The new nut 705402730 is now available, though it will be limited quantity for the coming weeks, we will be operating under a selective release system until we have enough parts available to ensure all dealers receiving a fair quantity of the wheel nuts, we will be putting priority for the first batch of wheel nut towards the southern states of the USA due to the fact that the first released units were shipped in these areas. Parts are already on his way to the international distribution center.
