PURPOSE

On November 8, 2019, MMNA submitted to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) a Defect Information Report regarding certain 2012-2017 i-MiEV vehicles.

Due to the design of the brake vacuum pump, water may penetrate the brake vacuum pump, causing corrosion. If sufficient corrosion occurs, the brake vacuum pump may become inoperable. If the brake vacuum pump becomes inoperable, this may result in increased stopping distances, which can increase the risk of a crash.

You will be notified again when additional updates become available. IMPORTANT

Affected new or used inventory vehicles must be repaired before the vehicle is sold/delivered. Dealers must check their inventory vehicles' VINs on the Warranty Super Screen to verify whether the vehicle is involved in this recall campaign. It is a violation of Federal law for a dealer to sell/deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire) covered by the notification under a sale or lease until the defect or noncompliance is remedied.
