Mercedes-Benz AG ("MBAG"), the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has determined that on certain Sprinter vans (platform 907 (VS30)), the lashing rails on the left and right side walls were not installed according to manufacturing specifications. As a result, the lashing rails may not have a sufficient amount of adhesive and/or an incorrect positioning of the adhesive and lack the activator necessary for the adhesive to fully cure. If the lashing rails were not installed per specification, over time, the lashing rails could separate from the side walls of the vehicle, which could lead to the items being transported to become unsecured and shift inside the cargo compartment while the vehicle is
